1. Attended Telluride Senior Meals had a meeting with Andy Alexander on behalf of TAR and an Angel Basket board member to discuss bringing Senior Meals under the nonprofit designation of Angel Baskets, allowing them access to funds from Region 10 and others.
2. Discussion of the Placerville Post Office with Roger of the United States Postal Service.
3. The County received a grant for two new EV trucks. Ford has ceased making this model, so we'll be receiving two of the last! With a grant Starr got, we will get two trucks for the price of one. New charging stations will be installed at the courthouse and elsewhere. The goal is to have two EVs in Telluride and one in Norwood. The county will now have 4 EVs in total.
4. Road and Bridge attended their annual avalanche training in Rico.
5. Improvements will be made to the Miramonte building, including increased accessibility.
6. Met with El Pomar; they're supporting the Youth Hangout Center with \$15,000/year and Norwood + Rico Fire with \$5,000 in operating grants, and requested new fire equipment on behalf of the Egnar Fire Department. Secure Rural Schools Funding was approved,

which would bring a smaller amount of federal funding to our schools.
