**A RESOLUTION OF THE

SETTING THE VEGETATION CONTROL & MANAGEMENT FEE SCHEDULE**

Resolution #2023 - 03

Whereas, pursuant to C.R.S. §35-5.5-101, the Board of County Commissioners of San Miguel County, Colorado ("Board") is authorized to manage the business and budget of San Miguel County, and to establish noxious weed management criteria, noxious weed management plans, fees for herbicide management of noxious weeds, fees for mechanical treatments of noxious weeds, and to charge fees that cover the direct and indirect costs of such services; and

Whereas, the Vegetation Control & Management Department requested the establishment of new service fees to cover additional staff time and costs related to noxious weed management, which involve both herbicide and mechanical treatments; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board finds that setting Vegetation Control & Management fees for Noxious Weed Management is necessary to cover current costs to provide noxious weed control services, and noxious weed management plans and further the Board finds that the proposed new fees to cover noxious weed management and noxious weed management plans are necessary to cover related costs to conduct such reviews. Therefore, the Board approves the revisions to the Vegetation Control & Management Fee Schedule as proposed by Staff and attached hereto as "**Exhibit A.**"

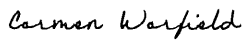

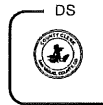
